

BUCHAREST OVERVIEW




Compared with the results obtained at the last local elections held in 2016, at this year's elections:

- PSD keeps the Bucharest City Hall, but the mayor will have to execute its capacity without a majority in the General Council
- □ In addition, PSD will lose 3 districts, but secure the majority in the local councils from districts 2,3,4,5.
- USR PLUS and PNL will win two districts, including District 1 which has the largest budget after the General City Hall
- □ In those districts where it wins, USR PLUS and PNL will need to attract PMP councilors to lock a majority
- PRO Romania marks a victory with Robert Negoiță, former PSD, but he will have to push his agenda by aligning with his former peers who will form a majority in the local council




NATIONWIDE OVERVIEW (1)



- On Sunday, PNL is expecting to secure its largest victory in local elections in the last 30 years. Its target is to have in the end the largest number of mayors in both rural and urban areas. In this sense, PNL, currently holding 1100 mayors, is aiming to increase this number by more than 25%, thus becoming the largest political force in Romania.
- ❑ USR PLUS will most likely not manage to have a significant number of mayor candidates elected. However, when it comes to winning seats in local councils, they will be more successful thus becoming a significant player to be taken into consideration in all future negotiations. As such, this will grant them a good starting point for the general elections to be held in December 2020.

NATIONWIDE OVERVIEW (2)

2016



- In 4 counties, namely Gorj, Galați, Vrancea, Mehedinti, the results concerning the political majority at county level are too close to call. These are counties traditionally awarded to PSD
 PNL will win two PSD flagships Iasi (Moldova) and Constanta (Dobrogea). However, Mihai Chirica, the mayor of Iași, is a former member of PSD and he will have to be flexible to negotiate with the liberal councilors as his candidature on behalf of PNL generated a great wave of discontent at the level of PNL Iași.
- PNL will recover Neamt and Sălaj
- PNL might set a footprint in Vrancea and Argeş, other PSD flagships
- PNL will win in other two red counties Hunedoara and Caraş-Severin




